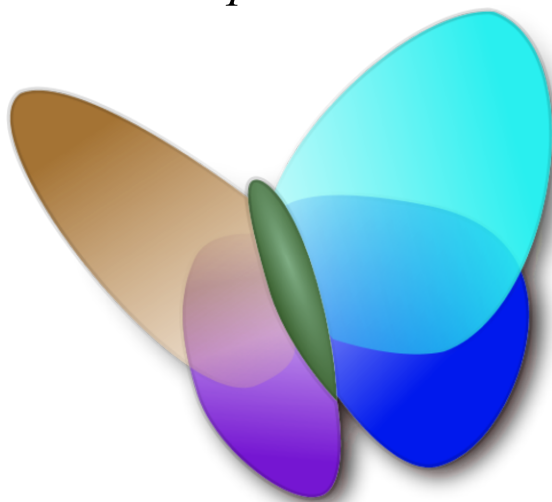

# Wamego High School Concert Band

## Emperata Overture.....Claude T. Smith

This first published work of Claude T. Smith was released in 1964. Over the ensuing years it has become the standard of comparison in concert band literature. The mixed meter along with the lyrical freshness typical of Smith ushered in a new era for composers writing for concert band.

## Sleep.....Eric Whitacre

“Sleep” began its life as an a cappella choral setting, with a magnificent original poem by Charles Anthony Silvestri. The chorale-like nature and warm harmonies seemed to call out for the simple and plaintive sound of winds, and I thought that it might make a gorgeous addition to the wind symphony repertoire. *(Program notes by the composer)*

## Variations on “Scarborough Fair” .....Calvin Custer

The familiar folk melody is stated first by a solo flute, then followed by a remarkable series of variations starting with a brass choir accompanied by woodwind flourishes. An Andante variation features the woodwind choir accompanying solos by baritone and oboe, and this leads to a striking fugue variation and bold finish.

## Serenade for Horn and Band.....Barry Milner

*Featuring French Horn Trio—*

*Dr. Jacqueline Fassler-Kerstetter, Kylee Gardner, Colton Gardner*

This uplifting and inspirational solo for Horn was written for Jamie Stidham-Matheney, a Horn player and friend of the composer. The beauty and majesty of the Horn is brought into its full glory in this lyrical piece. We feature Dr. Kerstetter and our very own senior French Horn players, Colton and Kylee Gardner on this piece.

## Circus Days (March).....Karl King/ arr. Schissel

Karl L. King published more than 300 works for band: galops, waltzes, overtures, serenades, rags, and 188 marches and screamers. It could be said that Karl King did for the circus march what Sousa did for the patriotic march.

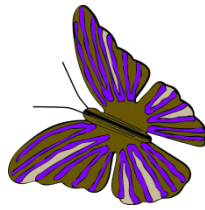
