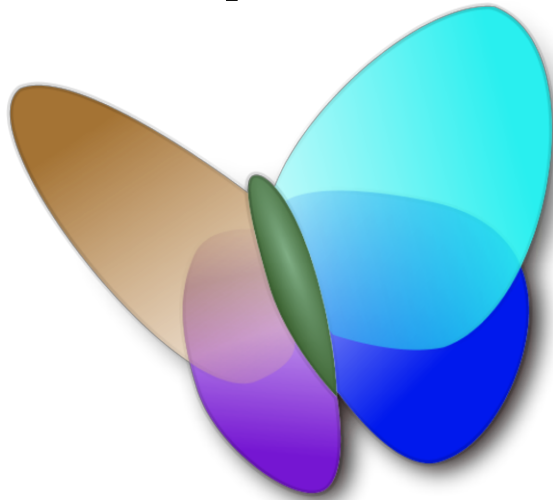

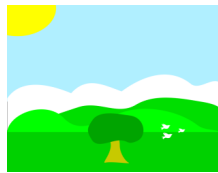

## Of Pride and Celebration.....James Swearingen

James Swearingen was Director of Bands in Grove City High School near Columbus, Ohio for many years before becoming Professor of Music Education at Capital University in Columbus. He was also a staff member and arranger for The Ohio State Marching Band. Jim Swearingen's compositions ushered in a new era for composers writing for concert band.

## Dusk.....Steven Bryant

This chorale-like work is meant to capture the contrast between the calm of dusk and the fiery hues of sunset. Starting small and somber, this piece builds until every instrument is playing before dying back down as if sunset had just given way to dawn. And while there isn't one specific melody to take home with you, you will leave this piece feeling calmer and more at peace.

## Carmen Suite.....Georges Bizet/ arr. Bullock

Georges Bizet (born 1838 in Paris, France) was the son of musical parents. At the age of nine, he entered the Paris Conservatory to study piano, organ, harmony, and composition. Although he wrote for many types of groups, he is best known for his opera, *Carmen*. The opera was first performed in March, 1875 and received 37 performances during its first season.

## Escape from Chronopolis.....Reber Clark

The story concerns a future time, when clocks and timepieces have been banned. It seems that Chronopolis, the Time City, was overrun with clocks. The city grew so large and intricate that only by timing everything to the millisecond would all run smoothly. Living under the pressure of nanoseconds was too much for the human organism to endure. All timekeeping was eventually banned. Chronopolis (the story) follows one man's search for a return to timekeeping.

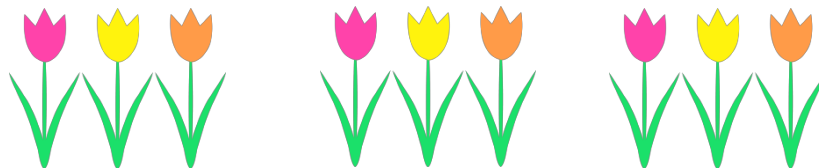
## Concerto for Trombones.....Norman Leyden

In keeping with the style of Karl King's music, the piece begins with a more detached style that contrasts the smooth, more legato style in the Trio.

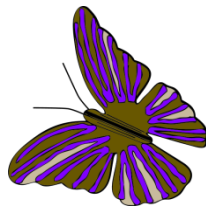
